WHEREAS, RPM Development Group LLC has proposed to redevelop a portion of the Property with an affordable housing project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the proposed redevelopment of the Property by RPM Development Group has been found consistent with the Redevelopment Plan and the Township's goals for redeveloping the Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, the Township is desirous of designating, RPM Development Group as redeveloper of the Property subject to certain conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Montgomery that RPM Development Group, 77 Park Street, Montclair, NJ 07042 is hereby conditionally designated as redeveloper for the redevelopment of a portion of Orchard Road and Headquarters Park Drive, also known as Block 20001, Lot 10.05 for the Project and reasons set forth herein.

- 2. That RPM Development Group, LLC agrees to pay any and all costs incurred by the Township from the date of the conditional designation to execution of a redevelopment agreement or termination of the redeveloper designation, as set forth herein. The escrow deposit shall be in the amount of \$10,000.00.
- 3. Within fourteen (14) days of the adoption of this resolution, RPM Development Group, LLC and the Township shall enter into an escrow agreement.
- 4. That RPM Development Group, LLC shall apply for and secure funding from New Jersey Housing Mortgage Finance Agency and other funding sources for the Project.
- 5. That RPM Development Group, LLC and the Township shall negotiate and agree upon the terms and conditions of a redevelopment agreement within the period of the conditional designation, as such period may be extended by the Township in its sole discretion.
- 6. That the Township shall obtain approval from the Somerset County Improvement Authority for the conveyance of the Property to itself or the Redeveloper for the Project.
