D. RESOLUTION #22-4-107 - AUTHORIZATION TO EXTEND SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER WITH THE BOROUGH OF ALPHA

WHEREAS, the Township of Montgomery, effective April 16, 2021, had entered into an agreement with the Borough of Alpha in order to share municipal services provided by the Township of Montgomery's Chief Financial Officer or Certified Municipal Finance Officer ("CFO"); and

WHEREAS, the Township of Montgomery desires to extend the agreement with the Borough of Alpha to have the CFO of Montgomery continue to provide services to the Borough of Alpha as a CFO/Treasurer pursuant to the attached shared services agreement (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, both parties have the authority to enter into the attached Agreement pursuant to New Jersey law, including the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, $N.J.S.A.\ 40A:65-1$, et seq.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Montgomery, in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. The Township of Montgomery hereby authorizes a three-year extension of the shared service agreement with the Borough of Alpha wherein the Township of Montgomery's Certified Municipal Finance Officer serves the Borough of Alpha for a term of April 16, 2022 through April 15, 2025.

6. RESOLUTION #22-4-114 - AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A COMPETITIVELY BID CONTRACT FOR COMMUNICATION CONSULTING SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Township of Montgomery (the "Township"), requires the services of a qualified Communication Consultant to provide clear and concise information to Montgomery residents via agreed to forms of digital and print media, including social media outlets ("Communication Consulting Services"); and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law at N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.1(b) (m) permits competitive contracting to be utilized to procure consulting services that warrant a qualitative evaluation of specialized goods or service providers to determine the provider that is most advantageous, price and other factors considered; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.3(a) requires that to use competitive contracting for a specified purpose, the governing body shall pass a resolution authorizing the use of competitive contracting for such purpose; and

WHEREAS, Resolution #22-1-48, approved on January 20, 2022 authorized the Township to use competitive contracting to procure the Communication Consulting Services; and

WHEREAS, on February 2, 2022, the Township issued a Request for Proposals ("RFP") to solicit Proposals for the provision of Communication Consulting Services and received three (3) proposals; and

WHEREAS, proposals were received from Fuerza Strategy Group, Stepping Stones Strategies, LLC and TeliApp Corporation; and

WHEREAS, the Township organized an evaluation team to conduct a comprehensive evaluation of the proposals and prepared a report attached hereto (the "Evaluation Report") recommending that the contract be awarded to Stepping Stones Strategies, LLC; and

WHEREAS, the term of the contract is one (1) year, with options to renew the contract for up to two (2) additional one (1) year terms; and

WHEREAS, the hourly rate to provide the Communication Consulting Services is one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and fifty (50) hours per month is recommended for the provision of the services; and

WHEREAS, the total cost to provide Communication Consulting Services for the one (1) year contract shall not exceed \$60,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified the availability of funds to award this contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Montgomery, Somerset County, New Jersey, that:

- Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:11-4.1 et seq., a contract in an amount not to exceed \$60,000 for providing communication consulting services is awarded to Stepping Stones Strategies, LLC;
- 2. The term of the contract is one (1) year, with options to renew the contract for up to two (2) additional one (1) year terms;
- 3. the Mayor or Township Administrator are authorized to execute the Contract to be prepared by the Township Attorney;
- 4. Notice of this action, including the nature, duration and amount of contract to Stepping Stones Strategies, LLC shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality within ten (10) days of this award;
- 5. The resolution authorizing the award of this contract itself shall be available for public inspection.
